Scents of pepper, cola and allspice jazz up plummy fruit, while the tannins that appear so supple on this medium to full-bodied wine's mid-palate firm up and dry out a bit on the finish.</p>

Reviewed by  Joe Czerwinski	<p>The estate's top wine, the 2016 Cotes du Rhone Villages Saint Maurice Guillaume de Rouville is 95% Syrah and only 5% Grenache, all whole-cluster fermented in a large oak cuve and then matured in concrete. The result is spicy—the wine offers up hints of clove, pepper and cinnamon—but lacks obvious cedar or vanilla influences. Dark-skinned fruit rounds out the full-bodied, creamy-textured mid-palate, finishing long, with touches of velvet and silk.</p> <p><i>Owner-winemaker Adrian Fabre actually runs two wineries—Domaine de l'Echevin is his father's family estate, while Domaine Florane is his mother's. Scents of cola, plum and spice make a great first impression, followed by a wine that's full-bodied and richly tannic but not hard or tough. The sexy 2016 Cotes du Rhone Villages Saint Maurice Guillaume de Rouville Blanc is a blend of 30% each Grenache Blanc, Marsanne and Roussanne, with the last 10% being Viognier. All barrel-fermented in demi-muid, this medium to full-bodied wine has it all, from floral notes to honeyed pineapple and tangerine. The silky texture softens and enriches the mid-palate, lingering through the finish. It's so delicious now, I wouldn't hold it more than a year or two.

Owner-winemaker Adrian Fabre actually runs two wineries—Domaine de l'Echevin is his father's family estate, while Domaine Florane is his mother's. Both are run along biodynamic principles and turn out some of the best wines in the Côtes du Rhône Villages. Basically, Florane is in Visan and l'Echevin is in Saint Maurice.
